Filing for Individuals

Information on filing your federal tax return.

Filing Past Due Tax Returns

File all tax returns that are due, regardless of whether or not you can pay in full.

View Your Account Information

You can use this tool to view: your payoff amount, the balance for each tax year for which you owe, up to 24 months of your payment history, and key information from your current tax year return as originally filed.

Payment Options

Pay with your bank account for free or choose an approved payment processor to pay by credit or debit card for a fee. Also available at the **IRS2Go app**.

Apply Online for a Payment Plan

Meet your tax obligation in monthly installments by applying for a payment plan (including installment agreement).

Estimated Taxes

<u>Pay as you go, so you won't owe</u>. Having enough tax withheld or making quarterly estimated tax payments during the year can help you avoid problems at tax time.
